The item was deferred, as the Council must await further discussions regarding the future set-up of the motorhome park before a decision can be made.		
	Carcass Report:		
	The Clerk reported to the Council that an individual had notified her of a deceased deer washed up on the beach. The Clerk attended the site, documented the matter, and has been in communication with CCC regarding its removal. CCC has confirmed that they are responsible for the removal of livestock from public areas; however, as a deer is not classified as livestock, there is uncertainty as to whether they will be able to assist in this instance.		
	Planting Committee:		
	NB is establishing a committee for the planting group and will prepare a constitution. She will also approach Parc Cynog regarding potential grant funding. HT confirmed he is happy to supply boards, and the Council will look at forming a working group to progress the project. If volunteer numbers or time constraints become an issue, the Council will consider commissioning a carpenter, using funds raised from last year's Christmas event, to assist with the village planters.
